#### Want to Remove Your Grass? City of Mesa Incentives Have

**Increased!** Apply to remove established grass and replace it with a water-thrifty Xeriscape landscape and you may qualify to receive up to **\$1,100** from the City of Mesa. Two levels of incentives are available: 500 - 999 square feet of grass conversion is eligible for \$750, and more than 1,000 square feet is eligible for \$1,000. Add an eligible tree or two as part of your Grass-to-Xeriscape project for up to \$100 more. Xeriscape (zeer-a-scape) uses well-adapted plants, efficient irrigation, careful design and proper maintenance to produce landscapes that save water and energy. Xeriscape also provides wildlife habitat and creates shade. Visit the <u>Water</u> <u>Conservation webpage</u> to find out if you qualify.
